

Dear Bloomfield Township resident,

The spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) is severe and growing.

We in Bloomfield Township are taking every precaution we reasonably can to protect the citizens, Township employees and visitors to the community. This will result in a certain degree of inconvenience, but nothing is more important than the health and well-being of all the people in our community.

Over the last several weeks we have been looking at options of what action we can take.
