


The Charter Township of Bloomfield is home to 41,000 people.

It provides a full range of public services, including its own police and full-time fire departments, and road, water and sewer divisions.


Housing choices in Bloomfield Township range from magnificent estates on large lots to affordable homes for first-time buyers.
