



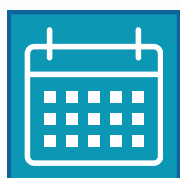

NOVEMBER 5 ELECTION

12 - 8 p.m.

TABULATE YOUR OWN ABSENTEE BALLOT

Bring your absentee ballot to Early Voting or Election Day to personally send it through the tabulator. If you were not sent an absentee ballot, lost/destroyed that ballot, or want to start over, you will be issued a precinct ballot to complete and tabulate.

ABSENTEE VOTING



Join the permanent mail ballot list. Apply once and receive a ballot for subsequent elections for as long as you qualify.

Get your ballot where you want it. Ballots are mailed to the voter's address on record in the Clerk's Office. The law prohibits the Post Office from forwarding an absentee ballot. However, you can indicate an alternate mailing address on your application or by advising the Clerk's Office in writing.




Sign the envelope and submit it containing your completed ballot by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day using one of these methods:

U.S. Mail postage pre-paid, but delivery times vary

Better



Use one of the Township Drop Boxes or drop off at Clerk's Office

Best



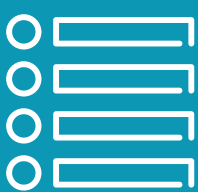
Send your own ballot through the tabulator during Early Voting or on Election Day

PRIMARY ELECTION CHECKLIST



ELECTION DAY IS AUGUST 6TH

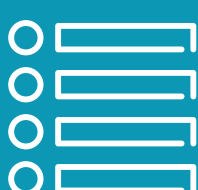
- Sample ballots available at bloomfieldtwp.org/elections.** Follow these requirements to ensure that all of your votes count.
- Vote Straight Party.** For the partisan portion of the ballot, you must vote for only one party by choosing from candidates in only one column.
- No overvotes.** An overvote occurs when you vote for more candidates than open seats. Undervotes are permitted.
- Write-in voting** requires you to fill in the rectangle next to the blank and write-in the candidate's name. Must be a valid write-in candidate.
- Remember to vote in any non-partisan race** or proposal.
- Check both sides** of the ballot.

GENERAL ELECTION CHECKLIST



ELECTION DAY IS NOVEMBER 5TH

- Choose your method.**
 - Straight Ticket.** Select party of your choice and your vote will be counted for that party in each partisan race without any further selections.
 - Split Ticket.** Select party of your choice. All partisan races will be tabulated as the party of your choice except for the races in which you make a different choice.
 - Mixed Ticket.** Decline to vote straight party option and instead make a choice in each partisan race on the ballot.
- No overvotes.** An overvote occurs when you vote for more candidates than open seats. Undervotes are permitted.
- Write-in voting** requires you to fill in the rectangle next to the blank and write-in the candidate's name. Must be a valid write-in candidate.
- Remember to vote in any non-partisan race** or proposal.
- Check both sides** of the ballot.
