This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of April 20, 2026, through April 26, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 514 calls for service, 187 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 44 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 25 Property Damage Crashes, 2 Personal Injury Crashes, 8 Hit and Run Crashes, 7 Private Property Crashes, 2 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

Retail Fraud 2nd
2105 S Telegraph Road

On April 26, 2026, at approximately 4:00 pm., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Dick's Sporting Goods, located at 2105 S Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. According to Loss Prevention, three juvenile males entered the store at 3:48 p.m. and walked into the men's clothing aisle. They selected multiple items and entered the changing rooms. At 4:04 pm., the suspects left the store without making any purchases. Four clothing tags, totaling \$307.00, were found in the changing room where the suspects were. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation. Anyone with information is urged to call Bloomfield Township at 248-433-7755.

Retail Fraud 2nd Degree
2105 S Telegraph Road

On April 21, 2026, at approximately 2:00 p.m., a Bloomfield Township Police Officer was flagged down in front of Dicks Sporting Goods, located at 2105 S Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. It was reported that a female and male suspect were inside of the store, concealing unpaid merchandise inside of a baby stroller. The suspects exited the store, without paying for the merchandise, and left the parking lot in a grey Ford Focus. Moments later officers stopped the Ford Focus and located the stolen merchandise (four men's Nike items totaling \$203.99). A 22-year-old black female and a 25-year-old-male were both arrested for Retail Fraud 2nd Degree. The Bloomfield Township Investigations Unit submitted warrants to the Oakland County Prosecutors Office for them and are waiting for authorization.

2400 S Telegraph Road

On April 20, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to 2400 S Telegraph Road, Target, for a Retail Fraud. Upon arrival, Target Loss Prevention had one female in custody for stealing 16 items including toilet paper, sheets, fake eye lashes and other self-care products totaling \$182.42. Loss Prevention stated they saw the female suspect select all the items, conceal them in her shopping cart as well as a BOG bag and then pass all points of sale without purchasing the items. The female was cited for Retail Fraud 3rd Degree and was trespassed from Target. She was released from the scene.

On April 20, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to 2400 S Telegraph Road, Target, for a Retail Fraud. Upon arrival, Target Loss Prevention had one male in custody for stealing a bottle of Svedka Vodka and a Monster Energy drink totaling \$24.68. Loss Prevention stated they saw the male suspect select the items, put them in his back pack, and pass all points of sale without purchasing them. The male was cited for Retail Fraud 3rd Degree and was trespassed from Target. He was released from the scene.
