This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of December 29, 2025, through January 5, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 434 calls for service, 146 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 33 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 19 Property Damage Crashes, 6 Personal Injury Crashes, 4 Hit and Run Crashes, 3 Private Property Crashes, 0 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 1 Non-UD-10 Crash.

Retail Fraud

2400 S. Telegraph Road (Target)

On January 4, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Target, located at 2400 S. Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. Loss Prevention reported that at approximately 4:15 p.m. two females entered the store, selected, and concealed several items. The females left the store without paying for the merchandise, but were stopped by Loss Prevention. The females willingly went to the loss prevention office, admitted to stealing, and turned over the stolen merchandise. \$143 worth of merchandise including cookies, socks, underwear, a vibrating wand, Vagisil, and tooth paste was recovered. The females left the store prior to our arrival. This case was assigned to the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation. On December 29, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report of a Home Invasion and Vehicle Theft in the 900 block of Harsdale Road. The victims reported that their black 2026 Cadillac Escalade was parked in the garage on December 28, 2025, at approximately 6:00 p.m. The victims woke up to find the Escalade stolen out of their garage. The garage door was left open and the keys were left inside the vehicle. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation. Larceny from Automobile
4600 block of Brightmore Court

On December 29, 2025, at approximately 4:00 a.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report for a suspicious person. According to the caller, an unknown person broke into his silver Cadillac Escalade. While responding to the call, officers observed a dark colored vehicle and a white Ford Expedition leaving the area of Brightmore Road. Officers attempted stop the vehicles but they fled. Officers began to pursue the vehicles, but stopped shortly after due to safety concerns. It was determined that the Escalade was unlocked and multiple people broke into it. The victim stated that \$140 to \$160 in cash was stolen from the vehicle. It is believed that this case is related to other cases of motor vehicle theft in the Township.
