Summary:

During the timeframe of January 6, 2025, through January 12, 2025, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 431 calls for service, 100 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 50 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 27 Property Damage Crashes, 4 Personal Injury Crashes, 5 Hit and Run Crash, 12 Private Property Crash, and 2 Car vs. Deer Crashes.
