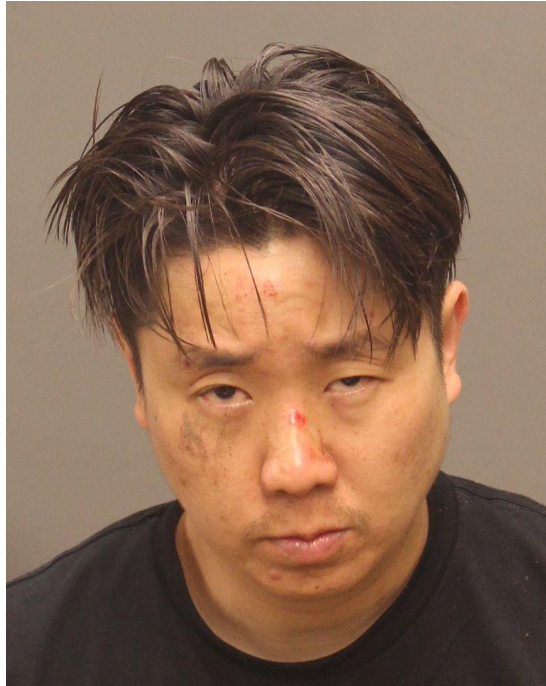

Attempt Home Invasion 1st Degree

Arrest Made

On June 21, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department made an arrest for Attempt Home Invasion 1st Degree. At 1:40 a.m. the Bloomfield Township Police Department received a 911 call from a resident stating a man was trying to break into the front door of their home. The victim reported that the man, dressed in all black, was stabbing his door with a knife and attempting to kick it in.

When officers arrived on scene they located Peter Chan-Woong Chung on the front porch of the home. Officers located the knife Chung was stabbing the door with on a window ledge near the front door. Chung was placed under arrest for Attempt Home Invasion 1st Degree. The door jam was splintered and the door sustained well over an estimated \$1000.00 in damages.

On June 22, 2025, Chung was arraigned by Judge Morad who set a \$25,0000.00 cash/surety/10% bond. Chung is due back in court on July 3rd.
