### **Summary:**

During the timeframe of June 1, 2026, through June 7, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 627 calls for service, 182 of which were traffic stops.

### **Traffic Crashes:**

Officers investigated 67 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 33 Property Damage Crashes, 9 Personal Injury Crashes, 11 Hit and Run Crashes, 8 Private Property Crashes, 3 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 3 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

**Retail Fraud**

**2400 S. Telegraph Road (Target)**

On June 4, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Target located at 2400 S. Telegraph Road for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. An unknown white male suspect entered the store and selected \$239.97 worth of assorted Lego sets and a carton of ice cream. The suspect proceeded to the self-checkout and paid for the ice cream using a gift card, but failed to scan or pay for the Lego sets. The suspect was leaving the store when he was confronted by Target staff. The suspect fled the store with the ice cream leaving the Lego sets behind. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation. **Vehicle Theft**  
**36600 Woodward Avenue (Mercedes Benz)**

On June 1, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department responded to Mercedes Benz located at 36600 Woodward Avenue for a report of a stolen Chevrolet Corvette. The black 2018 Corvette Z06 was owned by Mercedes Benz and listed for sale by the dealership. Video surveillance showed the Corvette's front lights flashing at 12:28 a.m. that morning. The Corvette left the parking lot heading northbound on Woodward Avenue. The dealership was in possession of both sets of keys for the vehicle at the time of the theft. Officers took the report and entered the vehicle as "stolen". On June 4, 2026, at approximately 4:45 a.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was notified by the Detroit Police Department that the Corvette had been located within their city limits. Detectives responded to the area and recovered the stolen Corvette. This case remains under investigation by the Bloomfield Township Police Department, anyone with information regarding the theft of this vehicle is urged to contact the Bloomfield Township Police Department at 248-433-7755.
