This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of March 10, 2025, through March 16, 2025, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 526 calls for service, 152 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 42 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 4 Car vs. Deer Crashes, 3 Hit and Run Crashes, 5 Personal Injury Crashes, 15 Private Property Crashes, 13 Property Damage Crashes, and 2 Rollover Crashes.

Telegraph Road / Hickory Grove Road ARREST MADE

On March 16, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department made an arrest for Operating While Intoxicated near Telegraph Road / Hickory Grove Road. Officers responded to the area for a report of a rollover crash. The vehicle was located but the occupants of the vehicle had fled on foot. Our K9 officer was able to track the occupants southbound on Telegraph Road into a wooded area near Hickory Grove Road where they were located.

Carlos Ramirez, the driver of the vehicle, admitted to having consumed "a couple beer sand was subsequently arrested for Operating While Intoxicated. Ramirez was then transported to the nearest hospital for his injuries.

Carlos Ramirez has been released from the Bloomfield Township Police Department's custody pending blood toxicology results.

25-4494 Retail Fraud 3rd Degree 2400 S. Telegraph Road

On March 13, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department made an arrest for Retail Fraud 3rd Degree at Target, 2400 S. Telegraph Rd. A Target loss prevention officer had detained Vijaya Chalichama Rao for stealing two Barbie dolls valued at \$33.90. Loss prevention stated Rao entered the store with an unopened "Ken" Barbie doll in a Target plastic bag. Rao went to the toy section and selected two more of the same kind of Ken dolls off the shelf. Rao then brought all three of the dolls to customer service, tried to return all three of them but was denied. Rao then started to walk towards the exit with all three dolls, passing all points of sale without attempting to pay for the merchandise. Rao was issued a citation for Retail Fraud and released from the scene pending her court date at the 48th District Court.
