This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of May 11, 2026, through May 17, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 528 calls for service, 222 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 35 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 23 Property Damage Crashes, 4 Personal Injury Crashes, 4 Hit and Run Crashes, 2 Private Property Crashes, 0 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 2 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

2400 S Telegraph Road

ARREST MADE

On May 13, 2026, at approximately 6:00 p.m. the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Target, located at 2400 S Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud that just occurred. When officers arrived, the suspect was still on scene with Target Loss Prevention. They stated that the suspect entered the store, selected a few items of clothing as well as a black purse then entered the self-check out area. The suspect did not pay for the items and left the store. The items stolen were valued at \$59.00. Loss prevention specialist stated the same individual was also responsible for three other separate Retail Fraud's at their store. The suspect was issued a citation for Retail Fraud 3rd Degree and released from the scene.

On May 17, 2026, at approximately 2:00 p.m. the Bloomfield Township Police Department responded to a Larceny that just occurred. The victim listed his iPhone 17 for sale on Facebook Marketplace for \$725.00. A male, contacted him about buying the phone and they agreed to meet at 1101 Westview Road, Bloomin' Preschool, to complete the transaction. When the victim arrived he met the suspect, described as a 5'9", lighter skinned black male in his late 20's, with a medium afro, wearing a pink shirt and blue shorts in the parking lot of the school.

The victim showed the suspect the iPhone near the back of his vehicle. The suspect snatched the phone from the victim and ran back to his grey Buick Encore. The victim tried getting the phone back from suspect. During the altercation the suspect closed the victim's leg in the door of the vehicle, injuring it. The suspect fled the area in his Buick with the stolen iPhone. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation.
