This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of September 29, 2025, through October 5, 2025, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 491 calls for service, 107 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 58 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 30 Property Damage Crashes, 6 Personal Injury Crashes, 9 Hit and Run Crashes, 10 Private Property Crashes, 2 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 1 Non-UD-10 Crash.

25-20360 Larceny from Automobile 400 block of N. Williamsbury Road

On October 3, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department responded to the 400 block of N. Williamsbury Road for a Larceny from Automobile that occurred the day prior. The victim stated that she parked her vehicle on October 2, 2025, at approximately 11:00 a.m. and discovered the theft on October 3, 2025 at approximately 8:15 a.m. The vehicle was rummaged through and multiple gift cards and \$20 cash were stolen from inside. The vehicle was parked in the driveway and left unlocked. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations unit and is currently under investigation. We remind all residents to lock your car doors and not to leave any valuables inside.

25-20289 Retail Fraud

1801 S Telegraph Road (Lowe's)

On October 2, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report of Retail Fraud from Lowe's, located at 1801 S Telegraph Road. Employees reported seven incidents of theft with items totaling \$1,272.36 dating back to July 2, 2025. All thefts were committed by the same suspect who investigators are attempting to identify. On October 2, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report of Larceny from Automobile in the 2000 block of Bradway Boulevard. The victim parked her car the night prior at approximately 7:30 p.m. and returned to the vehicle rummaged through at 8:15 a.m. Nothing was taken from the vehicle and there were no signs of forced entry into the vehicle.
