Township

Renewal of Road Maintenance Millage
Shall the Charter Township of Bloomfield be authorized to renew up to .6575 mills for a period of ten years to finance continued road maintenance, commencing with the December 2027 levy? Approval of this proposal would permit a tax of \$0.6575 per \$1,000 of taxable value on all taxable property in the Township. This proposed millage is a renewal of a previously authorized millage which expires in 2026. This millage will be subject to applicable constitutional tax limitation provisions at the time of levy, and will not exceed the above-stated rate. It is estimated that this proposal would result in the authorization to collect \$3,929,885 in the first year if approved and levied.

Renewal of Public Safety Millage
Shall the Charter Township of Bloomfield be authorized to renew up to 1.8428 mills for a period of ten years to finance continued fire, police and public safety protection, commencing with the December 2027 levy? Approval of this proposal would permit a tax of \$1.8428 per \$1,000 of taxable value on all taxable property in the Township. This proposed millage is a renewal of a previously authorized millage which expires in 2026. This millage will be subject to applicable constitutional tax limitation provisions at the time of levy, and will not exceed the above-stated rate. It is estimated that this proposal would result in the authorization to collect \$11,014,437 in the first year if approved and levied.
